The Burt County Board of Supervisors met in regular session on Friday, March 28, 2025, in the Boardroom of the Burt County Courthouse in Tekamah, Nebraska, pursuant to adjournment of their last meeting. Notice of the meeting was given in advance thereof by Publication in the Lyons Mirror-Sun (3-20-2025), upon a 1st floor bulletin board within the courthouse and on the County's Website. County Burial Policy:

The Board discussed updating the policy and fees paid for County paid cremation services; the last fee set was \$1,650.00 in 2016. Jim Pelan from Pelan Funeral Services was present and explained that the amount no longer covers his costs for cremation only services. The Board approved updates to the policy which included the fee be set at \$2,500.00; upon motion by Kutchera, seconded by Richards. Motion Passed By Roll Call Vote: Ayes – Swanson, Kutchera, Titus, Pearson, Johnson, Richards and Connealy. Nays – none.

ZONING - **Lot Split:** signed by Chairman Connealy JASON RUWE -2.127 ac. in pt. NE 4 NE 4 of Sec.12, TWP 22N, Rge. 9 E. of 6 th P.M., Burt County, NE

Building & Grounds - ADA entrances: Bruce Nathan, Superintendent Supervisor Swanson discussed constituent requests to have a handicap parking spot designated on the East side of the building at the end of the concrete ramp in the alley. Bruce explained that the only ADA Handicap parking is on the South side at the end of the sidewalk, this is due to the grade of the sidewalks; all other sidewalk approached at all other entrances to the building are not the proper grade for ADA guidelines.

Blizzard/Snow Event: Emergency Manager Jason Redding-Geu:

March 19, 2025 ice, snow and high winds caused major power outage throughout the County and beyond. A Disaster Declaration was signed for Burt County; Jason reported that 29 other Counties and the State of Nebr. also signed Disaster Declarations. Estimates of damage were figured at around \$5 million for Burt County and \$55 million Statewide. Burt County Public Power had reports of approx. 1,000 poles broken; they had mutual aid from multiple Power Companies helping to restore outages; power outages occurred March 19 - March 28 for residents of Burt County. Burt County Road Department reported that during a time on March 19 they were unable to plow roads due to downed power lines; they also reported an incident of their department and the Sheriff's Department aiding stranded motorists during blizzard conditions. The County Board approved pay for employees for two days during which time the Courthouse remained closed. Jason reported areas in which he found a need for equipment for his department, such as: portable power station and Wi-Fi hot spot for EM offsite use, and generators for battery backup for the County's emergency radios/repeaters.

ROADS: Ann Chytka, Highway Superintendent

- (1) <u>BRIDGE INSPECTIONS for 2025</u>: 72 Routine Bridge Inspections and 7 Fracture Critical Structures. Chytka presented two (2) quotes; Mainelli, Wagner & Assoc. and Midwest Engineering Inc. Chytka recommended the board accept services of Midwest Engineering as they have been doing the inspections and are familiar with the County's structures. Motion by Richards, seconded by Johnson, to sign a contract with Midwest Engineering, Inc for Burt County 2025 Bridge Inspections at proposed rate of \$15,500.00. Motion passed By Roll Call Vote: Ayes Swanson, Kutchera, Titus, Pearson, Johnson, Richards and Connealy. Nays- none.
- (2) Chytka reported that she is working on a reimbursement policy for cleaning out Township Road ditches.
- (3) Recognized Nick French, road employee for stepping up to help stranded motorists; thanked the entire road crew for their work in clearing the roads and providing aid to Power Companies during the event.

Public Comment: (1) Jon Dockhorn, General Manager of Burt County Public Power District – Thanked Burt County for their support and assistance from the Emergency Manager, Roads and Sheriff's Departments. Thanked the County residents for their patience during the power restoration process. (2) Bill Price, Lyons- Thanked the County departments and Thanked Burt County Public Power for their work during the snow event and recovery process.

Report of Board Appointments: Jeff Kutchera shared FY24 services provided and reimbursement report from Region 4.

There being no further business to come before the Board at this time, the meeting adjourned upon motions by Pearson and Johnson at 10:26 A.M. Next Meeting: Wednesday, April 9, 2025 @ 9:00 A.M.
